Dr. Anita F. Gottlieb, president of Gottlieb & Associates and a Senior Consulting Associate of EKA, has more than 30 years of experience in managing and consulting with government agencies, not-for-profit entities, and higher education institutions. Dr. Gottlieb's work with EKA includes projects for the University of Hawai'i, the University of North Carolina, Syracuse University, and Virginia Commonwealth University and development of a plan for an innovative high school for Wake County, North Carolina.

Prior to assuming her position as staff director, Dr. Gottlieb served on the faculties of Old Dominion University; the American University; and Empire State College, State University of New York. In these positions, she was involved in policy development related to academic programs and university governance and served on several Middle States accreditation teams. She has developed programs in experiential learning and has extensive experience in adult education.

Dr. Gottlieb has managed and consulted with local, congressional, and statewide campaigns. She ran the campaign that elected the first racially integrated VA State Democratic Party officers. Dr. Gottlieb has been involved in public policy issues at the local, state, and federal levels and has done extensive work on the development of value-based public policy. Using her *Policy Tree®*, she has trained hundreds of state legislators on developing and communicating innovative, value based public policy and budgets.
